This study discusses the characterization of the main character in the film *Hotel Transylvania 1*. Animated comedy film released in 2012. CHAPTER 1

1.1 Research Background

Narrative characteristics can be obtained with a general description of the business of calculating the actions and words of the characters (supporting characters), according to their actions, words, and deeds. A character must follow the role of a character that has been written or created by the author (Keraf, 2017)

(Fitria, 2021) Characterization is a commonly used term. It includes not only the rigorous depiction of a person, but also the depiction of people as physical objects. Characterization is the way in which characters are created on screen through the acting, language, and voice quality of actors and actresses. Characterization is the representation of a person in a narrative or dramatic work.

Features have many ways to analyze. For example, we can analyze characterization through psychoanalysis, but in this section we will find evidence of characterization by action (Nurgiyantoro, 2021)

Character is a crucial component of both literature and film. Without a story, a movie could not exist. It also occurs in stories; a tale cannot be referred to as a tale without any characters. Character and characterization are crucial components in literary works because they help tell the story. Character and characterization are frequently used in dramatic or narrative works. Characters are the people depicted in literary works whose actions and dialogue help the reader or audience to comprehend their thoughts, feelings, goals, and motives. Character is a person in a literary work who has an identity of some sort (it need not be a strong one), an identity made up of appearance, conversation, action, name, and possibly ideas flowing through the head (Richard, 2018)

In current developments, many animations are available on various platforms in the world, one of the animations that is currently popular is the movie *Hotel Transylvania 1*. *Hotel Transylvania 1* is an animated film from Sony Pictures directed by Genndy Tartakovsky 2012. The animated film *Hotel Transylvania 1* tells the story of a dracula who experienced a change where he freed himself from prejudice against humans and opened his heart to good changes from fear, protective, closed and prejudice. Dracula learns that friendship is not dependent on a person's identity or existence, and that true happiness and love can be found outside the boundaries he has set for himself.

CHAPTER II

LITERARY REVIEW

This chapter consists of two parts, namely, previous studies and theoretical background, namely character, characterization, movie.

2.1 Previous stduies

The previous research, the researcher did not find research with the same title as the author's research title which discussed the characterization of the main character in the film *Hotel Transylvania 1*. However, the researcher only found a thesis which discussed the main character in the movie. The following are some of the previous research journals related to the author's title.

The first research was conducted by (Ifianti et al., 2020) with the title "Analysis of the Characterization of the Main Characters of the First They Killed My Father by Angelina Jolie". The purpose of this research is to present the quality of the film itself. The researcher considers two main characters in the film. They are the Loung Ung of his father Pa each described. The method used in this research is qualitative research and the findings of the investigation are all the phrases and dialogues between the characteristics associated with the film characters.

The second research was conducted (Fardhany, 2021) with the title "An analysis of Main Character and characterization in dangerous minds movie". The aim of this research is to find out the character and characterization of LouAnne Johnson as the main character by analyzing evidence from her dialogues and actions in the film. The method used in this research is descriptive-qualitative research, to answer the main characters in the film Dangerous Minds

The third researcher was (Hapsari et al., 2021) with the title "An analysis on the characterization of the main character in the phantom of the opera's film". They investigate and analyze the characterization of the main character through

dialogue and his interactions with other characters in the film Phantom of the Opera. The method used in this research is descriptive qualitative, to reveal the main characters in the film

Based on previous study some scholars conducted similarities and differences of research. The similarity is that previous studies focused to identify in general character in films, while this study focus on to identify the characterization of dracula in the film hotel transylvania 1

2.2 Theoritical Background

2.2.1 Literature Theory

There are many different ways to define literature. For some, it is the art of language; for others, it is a means of expressing emotions, ideas, thoughts, passions and beliefs. However, by using the language "beauty" as a means of expression, it might simply be considered to be a literary manifestation of the human aesthetic. defines literature as a creative form of writing that is not literally true, such as fiction. There are some factors that make it challenging to describe literature, however it may be regarded of as an art form that expresses feelings and thoughts rather than open scientific writing (Keraf, 2017)

Literature symbolizes "life," and "life" itself derives in large part from a social reality. It implies that literature, like all other forms of art, should serve as a mirror of society and serve to reflect current events. In addition to using his imagination or writing skills, the author should indirectly rather than explicitly relate his work to real life so that it appears that a social life issue is addressed there (Nudhi Angga Bramaditha, 2020)

Literature explores what it is to be human, and being human implies being affected by the society, the world, the universe, the time, and the eternity that we experience and imagine ourselves to experience. Many people are more interested

in studying and evaluating literary works like novels, short stories, or songs when discussing them. A movie is one of many literary works that also contains a number of elements that may have made it even more unique. However, the study of literature and the cinema are mutually exclusive, according to Bennett and Royle. Innovative methods to think about literature can be found through thinking about films (Bennet and Royle, 2015), Literature is a genre of art that is founded on original concepts, sentiments, and ideas that are expressed in language and are connected to cultural factors (Qeisthiani Yurizka, 2022)

Literature can be categorized based on its genre—fiction, non-fiction, poetry, or prose and according to its major forms, such as the novel, short story, or drama. Additionally, works are frequently divided into groups based on historical eras or on how closely they adhere to predetermined aesthetic standards. "Numerous attempts have been made to define literature. It can be described as "imaginative" writing, although that definition refers to fiction writing, which is not truly the case. However, even a cursory examination of what is frequently categorized as literature implies that this will work. Literature is not what people think it is, despitewhat they may have believed (Aviandani Aulia nasution, 2014)

Literature is a broad term for writing that aims to convey ideas, emotions, and outlooks on life (Claudia, 2022), An author uses a literary work as a vehicle to communicate his thoughts and ideas to readers. We might claim that literature and life are similar since writers often encounter numerous types of issues that arise in our everyday lives (Zuliya, n.d.) cited Loman as saying, "If language in daily life is the first framer, literature is the second framer." Drama is the particular form of narrative that is performed. It comes from a Greek word that means "action". Drama is a form of performance that can be found in theater, radio, film, and television.

2.2.2 Character

Character is one of the important elements in fiction. Characters are elements in the plot of a movie and characters are inseparable, because plot is not a series of events that happen inside and outside the character to describe the character. If we put it in word order, when we know "what happened to us" and "how to help them" then we must know the actions of the characters in that series of events (Latif, 2016)

(Winnie & Mu'in, 2015) He understands that the term character has two meanings. First, show how a person behaves. Second, the concept of character is closely related to personality. The concept of individuality is also linked to the concept of personality, which is defined as a set of values that guide people's lives. So it has to do with the values someone has. Character is considered as an imagery person created by the writer and completed with his or her personality or characterization (Artawan, 2020)

Since characters are the people who take part in the action of the story, any good fiction will begin with a character. Characters play a part in the development of a story and enhance its appeal. a persona that is obviously linked to experience and life. Kenney agrees, saying that naming a characteristic is the easiest way to describe it. Every character has a name because the author gives them a soul to make them more distinct (Kenney, 2022). In this interpretation, the character becomes an important element in the construction of the story. Every action of the plot should be a story worth paying attention to. for Consider (Andi Abualief Amrullah, 2017)

A flat character in literature is a character dominated by a single characteristic.

The phrase "round character" usually refers to a character with more complex and distinctive characteristics. Characters are people portrayed in a work of drama or

narrative who the reader infers have specific moral, intellectual, and emotional qualities based on what they say and how they naturally say it (dialogue), as well as what they do (action). Their motivation refers to the factors that underlie a character's temperament, desires, and moral character. From the start through the finish of a work, a character could be essentially "stable," or unaltered in outlook and disposition. The character shouldn't abruptly depart and behave in a manner that isn't believable given their disposition as we have grown to know it (Klarer, 2019)

There are 2 kinds of character there are character round and character dynamic:

- a. Round characters Round character presents us with more facetsthat is, their author portrays them in greater depth and in more generous detail.
 Round character also tends to stay the same throughout the story (Tarowiyatul Toyibah, 2018)
- b. A dynamic character is one who changes significantly throughout the story. Changes considered to qualify a character as dynamic include changes in perspective or understanding, changes in commitment, and changes in values (Burrow, 2012) Changes in circumstances, even physical circumstance, do not apply unless they result in some change within the character itself. By that definition, the protagonist is nearly always a dynamic character. A dynamic character is one whose personality evolves during the course of the story as a result of changes to the setting or plot (Khairunas, 2018)

Based on the explanation above, character can be understood as the qualities that a person has, which contribute to the development of his personality and distinguish one person from another. Character is formed as a result of genetic and

environmental factors, and appears in everyday attitudes and behavior. Character itself has 2 kinds, namely character round and character dynamic.

2.2.3 Characterization

Characterization produces characters, which means that they have been created in a specific manner. The author has specifically chosen to characterize his or her character in the kind conversations they have, the actions they take, how they appear, and other ways. Characterization is the art of giving a character life, giving the reader a sense of that character's personality, and giving that character something special. In other words, character is a by product of characterization while characterization is a process. (Burrow, 2012) the characterisation was succinct but thorough. It originates from future being accounts of historical figures and events that were ostensibly seen from a great height.

Characterization is the process an author uses to fully realize fictional characters, including their appearance and personalities (Morner and Rausch, 2022), Characterization refers to making fictional characters come to life, which is the most crucial aspect of fiction.

(Rahmawati, 2020), Characterization is a technique for presenting the characters in a fictional work. Characterization, according to this definition, is the accurate portrayal of the characters who actively participate in the plot by their deeds or is the depicting of clear images of a person (Naila Nurs Sa'adah, 2017), Characterization the process by which a writer revealed a character in a work of fiction or the approach of character portrayal (Karadilla, 2021)

Characterization in literature is the process of authors used to develop character and create images of the characters for the audience. In the other hand, it is a way in which the author revealed his character in a work of fiction or in another word characterization method of character portrayal (Bennet and Royle,

2015). In addition, it is very helpful to analyze the main character development.

There are two different approaches to characterization, including direct characterization and indirect characterization.

a. Direct Characterization

In direct characterization, the author literary tells the reader what they want them to know about the character. This can be done by the narrator, another character, or the characters themselves. direct characterization. Usually used in novels. The content is that the narrator tells the reader something about the characters. In addition, it has been noted that other external information such as names and other public comments may also be relevant.

b. Indirect Characterization

In indirect characterizations, the author shows us about the character to help us understand the character's personality and its influence on other characters. usually movies use it. Characterizations in films are different from novels because films are visual stories that tell the characterizations in films are more complicated and detailed than those in novels (Burrow, 2012)

The researcher use theory from experts in conducting this research on the characterization of the main character in the Hotel Transylvania 1. The author uses the character and characterization theory of (Edgar V Roberts, 1964) to analyze the characterization of the main character. This theory argues that characterization in literature is a broad oral representation of humans, especially in determining themselves through

(1). Behavior

In this view, behavior is more focused on the manifestation of personality qualities. Any response offered by the organism, be it a reaction, response,

answer, or justification. Behavior can also refer to a movement or series of movements; in other words, behavior can also refer to an activity or an action. The motivations behind attitudes. The motivation behind a character's positive or negative attitude will manifest itself in actual actions.

As a character reaction to stimuli that may come from outside the subject, behavior is also a character trait. The character may have the internal reaction. The environmental factor has the greatest influence on how behaviors change and develop. It is challenging for people to adapt to their new and shifting environments and engage in social interactions by making changes to the surrounding environment. Following that, a person's conduct will adjust to suit his or her demands in the new environment.

(b). Speech

One of the abilities is the ability to communicate with others through language. Speaking is a type of speech act that involves the production of sounds by the speech apparatus along with body language and facial expressions. The meaning of speaking has been defined in a number of ways, sound or significant words used to spread a message to others.

Billed as a form of entertainment, a film is a literary work consisting of a number of vivid images shot to create the appearance of a motion picture. visuals. As a result, any analysis of a point of view must address the speaker's personal qualities that shape what he says. Point of view and tone have a similar relationship to opinions in that tone reflects the speaker's attitudes toward his or her subject and audience, and these attitudes are inextricably linked to the speaker's point of view. But when you think about these parallels, emphasize: Tone focuses how language and structure are used to convey attitudes; character studies emphasizes everything related to character; and point of view highlights how attitudes are perceived.

Speaking is a tool that almost immediately communicates to the audience if the speaker is speaking—about both the conversation's topic and the audience—whether he is being calm and flexible when expressing his views, and whether he is alert and excited. Language is used to carry out the action of talking.

Speech actions are things that humans do using language in order to act, apologize, instruct, or approve. Speech acts are actions carried out through spoken language. After seeing the movie, you will understand the character's characteristics or character. One of them is by listening to how they speak. We can discuss the character's nature based on the way he or she speaks.

(3). Thought

Human mentality that can be shaped by a variety of factors. The ability of the human intellect to conceive of new possibilities from existing difficulties makes life simpler. thoughts and mental activities. Thinking enables one to successfully represent the world as a model and treat it in accordance with one's objectives, strategies, and preferences. Words like cognition, understanding, awareness, ideas, and imagination all refer to the same ideas and procedures. thoughts and mental activities. Thinking enables one to successfully represent the world as a model and treat it in accordance with one's objectives, strategies, and preferences. Words like cognition, understanding, awareness, ideas, and imagination all refer to the same ideas and procedures.

In a comprehensive interplay of thoughts added to judgments, abstractions, the simplification of thinking, imagination, and problem-solving, the process of representing new thoughts is generated from changing forms through information. The internal process of thinking is also seen in actions. The propensity to reason logically is cognitively linked to the logical thinking that occurs in daily life, such as while performing an action. a propensity to consider in terms of emotions and the

places where they are subjectively held and respond to information, including memories, routines, personalities, and beliefs.

The process of observing each piece of information that comes in about the character is carried out by the conscious mind. The five senses of sight and touch will then be used to process the incoming information. The mind then becomes conscious. When it comes to the character's responses and habits, both good and bad, the subconscious mind is involved. Positive and helpful behaviors are good habits. Meanwhile, harmful and negative habits like littering are terrible habits. Reflex behaviors, such covering one's mouth when coughing or sneezing, happen instantly. Feelings about a situation are called emotions. Personality is an aspect of each person that shows itself in how we interact with others and the world around us on a daily basis.

In Writing Themes About Literature (1964) He suggested four techniques to get special information about the character are:

1. What a particular character says about himself

In analyzing a character to find out the characteristics of character is seen from how the characters said Sometimes what a specific character says about himself is taken at face value as the truth, but other times it may merely be a reflection of his mental and emotional state at the time.and how he feels when other characters interact with him. "The words someone said are the result of what is felt and thought and then presented to the language. Most of what was stated above is relevant to how a character thinks as it is described to us by the author, who is acting in the role of an omniscient narrator. If you notice discrepancies between what a character thinks and what he or she says, you can be sure that the author is displaying some aspect of that persona that is either (a) favorable if the

discrepancy is a part of a worthwhile strategy or (b) unfavorable if it is a part of an ineffective or ignoble strategy.

2. What the character does?

When analyzing what a character does, you need to ask yourself whether the character's actions match their words. If not, why not? What is the author communicating by showing contradiction? Roberts will discuss how a character's response to circumstances in his life might be a good indicator of that person's personality. One's personality is largely influenced by their deeds.

3. What is the Other Character Said about the Character?

In his "Writing About themes Literature" Roberts explained "that the author in expressing a character does not only focus on how the written tells the character individually, but there is also the perspective of other characters, which is also made by the author to express certain characters in the depiction of a character". The role of others character in describing a character is very important. They can express it in a comment they make. In character analysis, the importance perspective of other characters is very influential as well because they are part of that character. In this case Edgar wants to explain that in expressing a character, there are different points of view. In to responding something, each individual has a different perception.

4. What the author says about the character.

Author is the master of the story. what an author writes about a character should be taken as fact. Naturally, the author must be completely believed regarding all facts in the story or drama. But when he analyzes the behaviors and traits of his characters on his own, he puts himself in the position of the critic, and his judgments are subject to challenge. Because of this, authors typically avoid making

overt interpretations and instead focus their talent on structuring the drama or story such that the reader can easily draw the author's conclusions. However, if the author decides to offer a character analysis, he may use a character in the work who will then be constrained by his own constraints

2.3 Synopsis

Hotel Transylvania is a 2012 animated comedy film in which the vampire Dracula builds a luxurious secret hotel in the middle of the forests of Transylvania. Stories about Dracula are always interesting. The same goes for animated movies. One of his cartoons about Dracula or vampires is "Hotel Transylvania" by Sony Pictures Animation. If Transylvania is usually equated with a haunted region with a gigantic eerie castle inhabited only by a lone vampire, this movie is something completely different.

Hotel Transylvania tells the story of a vampire named Count Dracula. After losing his wife to human acts, he is a single father of his only daughter. Dracula was enraged to lose his wife to human activity. Count Dracula built a luxurious five-star hotel called Hotel Transylvania to protect his daughter Mavis. Dracula then opened his Hotel Transylvania to all monsters, making it a monster-friendly haven without humans.

The hotel seeks to protect monsters from the dangers humans pose. Dracula has run this hotel impeccably over the years, staying true to its identity and providing a safe place for most people to rest and enjoy. But everything changed when a human named Jonathan happened to find the hotel his Transylvania.

Dracula tries to hide his true identity and forces Jonathan to act like a monster to avoid harming the hotel and visitors. Things get more difficult when Dracula's daughter Mavis falls in love with Jonathan and decides to have a relationship.

Dracula panics about his daughter's danger and tries to hide Johnny's whereabouts from the monster guests who are afraid of humans. Dracula concocts that Johnny is a "distant cousin" born from Frank's right arm. Unfortunately, Dracula forgot the most important thing, which is to keep Johnny away from his son. then things go wrong with Mavis falling in love with Johnny and Dracula tryingto throw Johnny out of the hotel before it's too late for him.

Mavis is always interested in people and eventually falls in love with Johnny. Dracula's closest friends include Frank and Eunice, Frankenstein, Wayne, Wanda and Hundreds of Children, Murray the Mummy, a family of wolves, and perhaps most interestingly Griffin the Invisible Man. On her daughter's 118th birthday, Dracula promises to get Mavis out of the hotel to explore the human world that her son has always wanted.

However, it turns out that Dracula tricked Mavis by creating a fake town consisting of bellboy zombies (Dracula's hotel employees) who pretended to be human. Dracula plans to scare Mavis out of her curiosity about humans.

Dracula doesn't just kick people out of hotels, so Dracula tries again when Johnny Stein is the host of Mavis' birthday party. Jonathan, who is a modern man, does not think that the program prepared by Dracula is very interesting.

He also made some changes, making all the monsters happy, especially Mavis. However, Dracula did not immediately accept the change. Dracula tries to drive Johnny away, but is captured by Mavis and takes the humans back inside. Then Johnny took Mavis to see the sunrise for the first time on the roof of the hotel.

Meanwhile, at the hotel, a group of other monsters question Dracula's decisions and resent the supposed safety of humans. The conflict escalates when Jonathan is revealed to be human, jeopardizing the hotel's existence and Dracula's friendship with Jonathan.

As the story progresses, Johnny continues to try to win Mavis' heart, proving that humans can be friends with monsters. When Johnny's secret is finally revealed, Dracula is faced with the difficult choice of protecting his daughter or admitting the truth about Jonathan's human existence through hilarious acts and unexpected upheavals.

Every animated movie has an antagonist. The film's antagonists are hotel chef Quasimodo and his pet mouse Esmeralda. Quasimodo convinced the monsters that Johnny was human, but of course Johnny Stain's physique was absolutely convincing, so none of the monsters believed him. Quasimodo and Esmeralda secretly kidnap Johnny and cook him. Quasimodo wants to reveal Johnny's true identity. This causes confusion for all the monsters except Mavis, who wants to be with Johnny even though they are in different worlds. However, Johnny was saved by Dracula, who froze Quasimodo instead to protect this secret.

Dracula also tells Johnny about the events that made him (and other monsters) avoid humans. When Mavis was a baby, people flocked to her house and managed to murder Dracula's wife. Then Johnny even avoided it because he wanted to respect Dracula. He also left Hotel Transylvania, causing Mavis to hate her father.

Dracula asks Johnny to stay at least until Mavis's birthday party is over so his daughter doesn't get sad. That night, Mavis and Johnny kiss, angering Dracula. Dracula realizes that she has gin in Mavis and Johnny as well as in her wife. She apologizes to both Dracula Mavis and the monster.

He admits to scaring the monsters about how dangerous humans are, unaware that humans have evolved and changed their view of monsters. Dracula also invites her best friends Frank, Wayne, Griffin and Murray to look for Jonathan. When the monsters go to the airport, a Transylvanian festival is held topraise and honor the monsters. Instead of fearing the arrival of real monsters, people were very happy to help them reach the airport safely. Unfortunately,

Johnny's plane had already taken off. Drak doesn't care if sunlight kills him, transforming into a bat and following his plane.

Dracula manages to apologize and take Johnny's plane back to the Transylvania airport. Dracula brings Johnny back to Mavis so they too can formalize the heat. Dracula realized that her daughter had grown up and that she had the right to make her own decisions. Monster (and Johnny) continue the party.

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

This chapter is divided into five subchapters. The sub-chapters consist of research design, data sources, data collection, data collection procedures and data analysis techniques. These sections will be explained as follows:

3.1 Research Design

The approach used in this study is a qualitative approach, this approach is one type of approach to analyze the characterization of Dracula. This approach aims to reveal Dracula's actions, dialogues, behaviors and emotions in the film *Hotel Transylvania 1*. In addition, a qualitative descriptive approach to the film *Hotel Transylvania 1* researchers can explore how Dracula influences and is influenced by other characters in the film and how Dracula experiences character changes.

Based on Bogdan and Biklen in (Truman et al., 2017) the characteristics of qualitative research are that research has a natural background and data sources must come directly from the research object. In addition, where the researcher is the key instrument. Qualitative research is descriptive in nature, data collection in qualitative research is mostly collected in the form of narration and argumentation

3.2 Data Resource

This research uses primary data information. Researchers took data from the film *Hotel Transylvania 1* (2012) by Peter Baynham and Robert Smigel to find out the characterization of Dracula using the Edgar V Roberts Theory (1964), the film was released in 2012, directed by Genndy Tartakovsky with a duration of 91 minutes. The data will be taken in the form of script excerpts. after that classify the data found based on the research objectives, namely to find the characterization of Dracula in the film *Hotel Transylvania 1*.

3.3 Data Collection

The collection in this research the researcher will do the picture documentation and notes. Documentation is a way of collecting data that produces important notes related to the problem under study. This documentation will be used to collect data in the form of images in *Hotel Transylvania 1* movie. By using documentation and notes, researchers will obtain data by looking at pictures and noting dialogues between characters from Movies that match the characterizations.

3.4 Data Collection Procedure

In order to collect data, the researcher conducted the following procedures of collecting data:

- First, the researcher watched the movie Hotel Transylvania as a whole carefully.
- Second, the researcher identify and analyze dialogue regarding Dracula's Characterization
- The researcher writes relevant dialogue that reflect Dracula's characterizations on notes cards
- 4. Then the researcher classifies the data related to the research object.

3.5 Data Analysis Technique

The data analysis technique used in this research is qualitative descriptive analysis technique. Qualitative descriptive analysis is a method that describes and provides insight into the object being researched. research through data or samples that have been collected (Sugiyono 2009, n.d.)

In analyzing research questions, data analysis techniques are needed (Miles 2020), namely data reduction, data modeling, and drawing conclusions which will be explained as follows:

a. Data Reduction

Data reduction refers to the process of analyzing data by summarizing, sorting and selecting important points, focusing on the important things, and looking for themes and patterns. besides data reduction is not something separate from analysis. Data reduction is a form of analysis that sharpens, selects, focuses, identifies what is included in the data if it is not included in the category of data we discard, and arranges the data in sucha way that "final" conclusions can be drawn and verified.

b. Data Display

Then, after conducting a rigorous data check, the researcher presents it in a descriptive qualitative form. display of data can be done in the form of brief descriptions, or the presentation of data consists of descriptive descriptions of selected and focused scenes and dialogues related to Dracula's Characterization

c. Conclusion

The final stage is to draw overall conclusions from the data that has been reduced and presented previously. This conclusion will be drawn if the data has been tested for truth and validity.

Drawing conclusions and verification is done by drawing conclusions on the summary of the data on the data that has been displayed so that the data has meaning. The verification or conclusion that will be carried out by the researcher is to draw conclusions on the results of the data that has been obtained from the results of preliminary research and the data that has been obtained and has been presented in text form on the data display.

CHAPTER IV

FINDING AND DISCUSSION

This chapter presents the result of this research. the researcher wanted to identify the characterization of dracula in the movie *Hotel Transylvania 1* based on the character theory of Edgar V Roberts . there two sub-chapters in this chapter; The findings the discussion refers to further discussion of the findings. those will be explained as follow:

4.1 Findings

In accordance with the research, the researcher wants to analyze the nature of dracula in the *Hotel Transylvania 1* movie. the researcher analyzes the data with behavior, speech, thoughts. the researcher uses the theory of characterization by (Edgar V Roberts, 1964)

1. Behavior

Behavior may also refer to an action or an activity, particularly behavior can refer to a movement or a series of movements. The attitudes' underlying motives. - Johnny, come with us.

- Glasses shaking?

Glasses shaking sideways!

Through The Looking-Glass? I stink

at this.

I didn't do that. And pull it back. And up. And push.

And twist. And back.

And up. And twist.

And push.

No. Don't copy that.

And back. And up. And twist. Let me get a bubonic

moose nose omelet with cockroach paste and

mouse jelly. And with egg whites.

Bonjour, Monsieur Dracula!

May I make you an omelet?

No, no, no, no. I'm not hungry.

There's too much I want you to remember.

You were right, Dad. The humans hate us.

Sweetheart, there are so many eligible monsters out

there. You're so young to...

"Your Zing will come, my love.

"Cherish it.

- You and Johnny?

leave.
